

KNOWLEDGE TEST INSTRUCTION

The Civil Aviation Directorate is organizing the theoretical exam for obtaining the certificate on having passed the knowledge test for the operation of unmanned aircraft. The exam is computer-based and is held per the dates for the current year in the Directorate's premises. The applicant is required to produce an identification document.

The applicant submits an application to the Directorate for taking the theoretical test for obtaining the certificate on successfully passing the knowledge examination for the operation of unmanned aircraft.

The knowledge assessment consists of taking an objective type multiple-choice test and is conducted on the Directorate's premises.

Applicants take the test in the subject of aviation regulations consisting of 40 questions.

The applicants will have passed the test if they score at least 75% of the questions correctly **in one attempt**.

If the applicant does not pass the test, he/she may apply for a re-examination.

If CAD establishes that the applicant failed to follow the examination procedures in the course of taking the test, it decides whether the applicant passed the test.

If it has been proved that the applicant attempted to pass the test fraudulently, the CAD will prohibit the re-taking of the examination for at least 12 months from the date of the test, which the applicant attempted to pass fraudulently.

After each examination, the applicants will receive the report on the results or receive the confirmation that they completed the test.

Information regarding the theoretical exams, the schedule for taking the current year, the location of the examinations, and the behavior of the applicants during the test, as well as a short presentation of the "Theoretical test" software package, can be found in Serbian and English languages on the CAD website.
