VALIDATION Part - FCL LICENSE FOR COMMERCIAL AND NON-COMMERCIAL AIR TRANSPORT

To Whom It May Concern

In accordance with the *ICAO State Letter*, referring to *Amendment 174 of Annex I ICAO*, or the validation of pilot licenses, the Republic of Serbia is obliged to validate pilot licenses for commercial or non-commercial operations of aircraft registered in the Republic of Serbia, <u>not later than 09 November 2017.</u>

The process of recognizing licenses issued in accordance with Annex I to the Chicago Convention is laid down in Annex III A. Regulation on Aircrews

In addition to the licenses issued in accordance with Annex I of the Chicago Convention, the Directorate will also revalidate pilot licenses issued by EASA Member States (Part - FCL). For validation of the Part - FCL license, applications must be submitted to the Directorate on the **DCV - PEL - OB - 108 form**. The form can be found on the Directorate's website: Aviation Personnel \rightarrow Flight Crew Personnel \rightarrow Airplane Pilots \rightarrow Forms. The form shall be accompanied by the payment of the administrative fee.

Individuals holding Part - FCL licenses issued in EASA Member States, who are engaged by operators or training centres, and who operate on aircraft registered on the Register of the Republic of Serbia must apply, as well as pilots of the mentioned aircraft engaged in noncommercial operations.

The process of validating Part - FCL licenses is an administrative procedure. The holders of the licenses are not be obliged to take any theoretical or practical exams, nor they are be obliged to pay any fees, except the republic administrative fee.
